Special Called Business Meeting - There will be a Special Called Business Meeting following both services **TODAY**. The purpose of this meeting is to consider the recommendation from the Leadership Council regarding the members to serve on the Executive Pastor search committee. In the August 18, 2019 Business Meeting the church voted to create the position of Executive Pastor to cover the duties of the current Church Administrator and to work alongside the Minister of Education with some of his responsibilities.



Late Monday night the Plano City Council voted 5-2 to approve the rezoning of our current church property. This action opens the door for the church to quickly close on the sale of the current property and purchase the new property on the George Bush Turnpike.

Thank you to all of those who patiently waited through a four-hour meeting to celebrate the outcome. Thank you to those who have expended so much time, effort and sacrifice in pursuit of this day. And most especially, thank you Lord Jesus for making a way and allowing us to move forward with clarity and prepare for another 167 years of ministry. To God be the glory forever and ever.

The next step will be to close on both the current and new church properties. First Baptist Plano arranged with InTown Homes to lease back the current church property for up to 23 months while the new property is under construction.
